

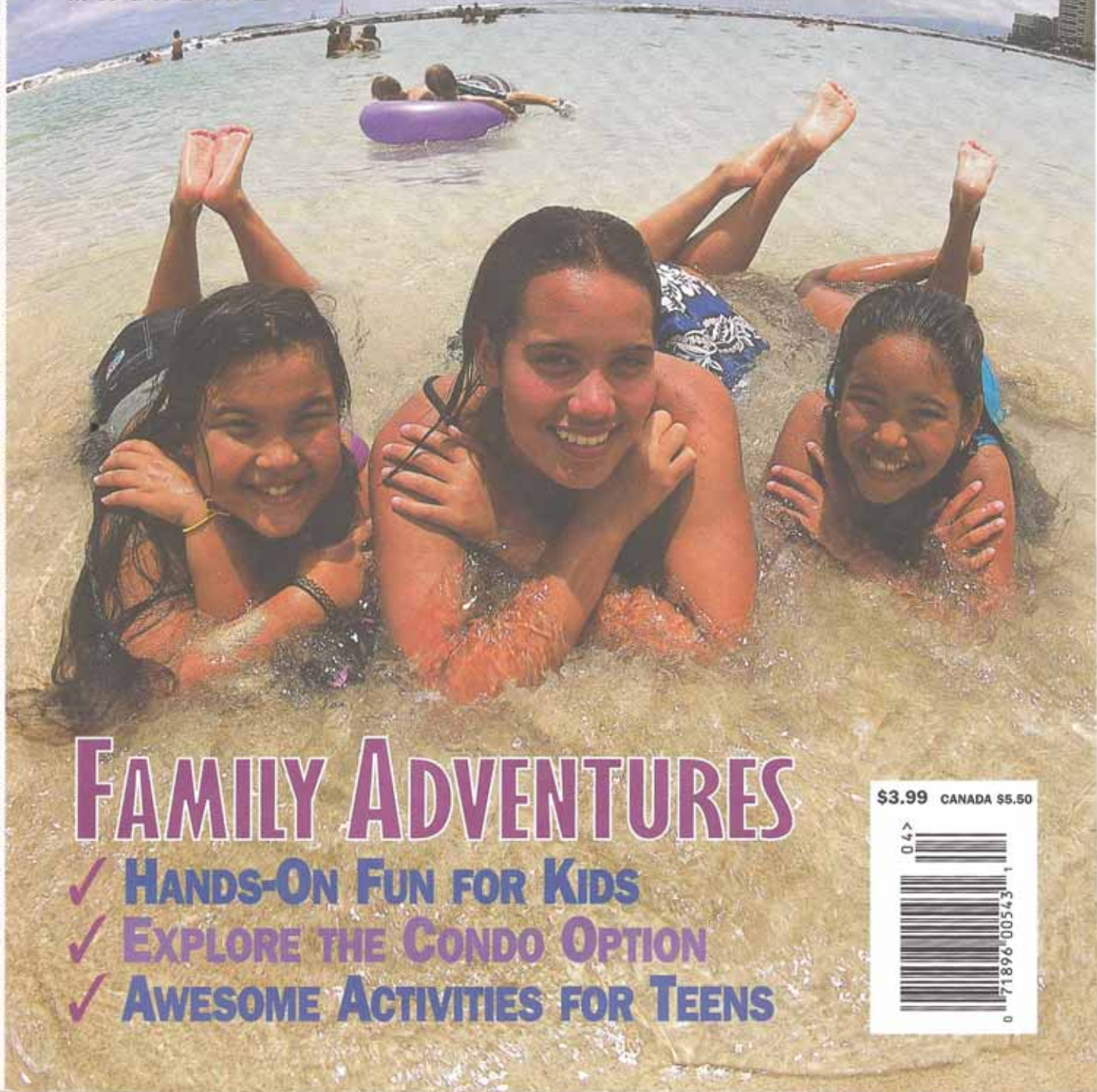

Aug. 30) and holidays (Dec. 23 through Jan. 4), adolescents age 13 through 17 can party at Teen Tropic Extreme Nights on Monday and Wednesday from 7 to 9 p.m. in the Camp Menehune Room of the Ocean Tower. Games, music and dancing make this a marvelous mixer. Admission is \$5 per person. (808) 886-1234.

ALL-TERRAIN ACTION: ATV Outfitters Hawaii takes intrepid visitors on adrenaline-pumping rides on all-terrain vehicles through the green countryside of North Kohala. During a trip, teens might see the Pacific from atop 200-foot cliffs, splash through mountain streams, pass herds of grazing cattle, find hidden waterfalls and zip through rain forests blooming with tropical flowers, trees and plants. Along the way, a guide shares tidbits about the history of the area, which is renowned as the birthplace of King Kamehameha I.

Three tours are scheduled Monday through Saturday. The 90-minute Historical Ocean Cliff Trail departs at 9 a.m. and 1 p.m., the two-and-a-half hour Waterfall Adventure leaves at 8 a.m. and 12:30 p.m., and the full-day Rainforest Waterfall Adventure goes out at 9:30 a.m. Prices are \$90, \$159 and \$250 per person, respectively. Participants must be at least 16 years old and weigh between 90 and 300 pounds to operate their own vehicles. Teens under the age requirement can enjoy the Historical Ocean Cliff Trail tour in the Scenery Machinery, a larger ATV driven by a guide. (888) 288-7288, www.outfittershawaii.com

During two-hour guided **Kahua ATV Tours**, teens can discover the beauty of Kahua Ranch, which spreads out over 8,500 acres on the western slopes of the Kohala Mountains and includes lush rain forests and arid desert. The tours go out at 9 a.m. and 1 p.m. on Monday, Wednesday, Friday, Saturday. No tour is alike because weather conditions and the experience level of the participants determine the itinerary, but common sights include horses, lambs, cattle and greenhouses where the ranch grows hydroponic lettuce, spinach and tomatoes. The cost is \$85 per person. A minimum age of 16 years and a maximum weight of 300 pounds apply for all drivers. (808) 882-7954.

BEAUTIFYING BODY AND SOUL:

Young people vacationing at the **Grand Wailea Resort, Hotel & Spa** during Christmas, spring break and summer can indulge in activities designed especially for their age group. Set in the Game in the Bar

nightclub, Teen Disco Night features dancing, billiards, shuffleboard and nonalcoholic drinks. Escapades Old-Fashioned Soda Shop offers another marvelous spot to mingle. Foosball, pingpong, video games and a menu filled with pizza, hot dogs, ice cream sundaes and such provide the draws.

On Teen Spa Night, they can enjoy three hours at Spa Grande, including aromatherapy; loofah scrubs; and the *terme* circuit, a series of water therapies that clean and invigorate the skin. Available separately is the Teen Facial, which addresses adolescents' skin-care needs. Beauty consultants

discuss the importance of skin care, explain the causes of acne and other problems, and recommend a cleansing regimen based on skin type.

From there, teen girls can visit the resort's Grand Design Salon for makeup lessons and application, specialty braids, and hair wraps using their choice of multicolored threads.

Snorkeling and whale-watching expeditions; sailing, tidepool and reef explorations; horseback riding; and visits to the Maui Ocean Center and the Hawaii Nature Center's Iao Valley Interactive Science Arcade are among the off-property excursions cur-
